Objectives

The objective of this option is to provide a framework for our students to be more present and active in associative, humanitarian or cultural projects (including social work, NGOs etc), thus better preparing them for their integration into the workforce and society at large.

The option seeks to develop leadership within an academic framework that adds value to both student initiatives and their education. The wide range of expertise of the school's staff, particularly amongst the teachers/researchers, provides excellent support for developing such student initiatives.

Course contents

The project commences in the autumn semester and continues through to the end of March in the spring semester.

In addition to a small number of taught classes, students are accompanied by both a teacher and a self-development professional.

Specific work sessions (such as project presentations) are organised on a regular basis.

Students are encouraged to attend classes organised within other professional options that may contribute to the success of their projects (e.g. project management).
