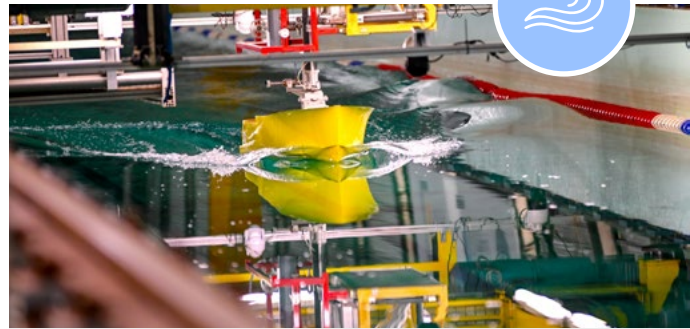
Alongside academic excellence, Centrale Nantes benefits from a **strong network of industry and institutional partners**, enabling cutting-edge research and innovation recognised across Europe and beyond.

EXPERIENCE LIFE ON CAMPUS

Centrale Nantes is home to over **2,000 students**, one third of whom are international, on a **40-hectare green campus** just minutes from the city centre.

Beyond classrooms, labs and research platforms, students have access to a **Fablab and a start-up incubator as well as excellent sports facilities** — from a gymnasium and squash courts to an artificial sports field and a climbing wall.

Campus life is lively and welcoming, with **more than 120 clubs and associations** to get involved in.



CUTTING-EDGE FACILITIES FOR RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

With 13 research platforms on campus, students have **access to exceptional equipment for their practical work** — from **ocean engineering tanks and vehicle and engine test benches to ecoconstruction platforms and advanced composite materials and processes.**

The on-campus FabLab is a creative hub open to the entire community. It combines high-tech equipment and expert guidance to support, train, and inspire students as they bring their ideas to life.

In the third year, choose a project-based specialisation in Mechanical Engineering, Fluids and Energy, Civil Engineering, or Signal Control and Robotics.



FURTHER STUDY OPPORTUNITIES

This accredited degree opens the door to further study, for example on a Master's programme at Centrale Nantes, or at another institution in France or internationally.



CLOSE TIES WITH INDUSTRY

Benefit from two integrated internships, plus regular input from industry professionals and guest speakers.

COURSE CONTENT

This three-year programme offers a strong scientific foundation while gradually opening the door to specialisation. The first two years comprise core courses, while the final year offers a project-based approach with specialisations in **Mechanical Engineering, Fluids and Energy, Civil Engineering, or Signal Control and Robotics**.

In line with the school's values, around one third of the curriculum focuses on humanities, social sciences, and languages, with **a strong emphasis on professional skills and entrepreneurship**. Students can expect around 20 hours of classes per week, with additional independent study playing a key role in consolidating knowledge and developing autonomy – while still leaving time for projects and campus life.

Close ties with industry run throughout the programme. External speakers and professionals play a key role, especially in the final year, ensuring **strong links between academic learning and real-world practice**.

CAREERS GUIDANCE

At Centrale Nantes, students receive **personalised support from our Careers Service** to help shape their professional journey. Guidance is offered through one-to-one sessions (on campus or online), meetings with graduates, webinars, and career forums.

As future graduates, students also gain access to a powerful network of more than **20,000 alumni across 44 countries** — opening doors to opportunities worldwide.

FURTHER STUDY

After the BSc, graduates can pursue a Master's degree in France or abroad. In 2026, our graduates joined programmes at Politecnico di Milano (Italy), TU Delft (Netherlands), Centrale Lyon (France), Universidad Politécnica de Madrid (Spain) and TUM (Germany) for example. Centrale Nantes also offers four fully accredited MSc programmes and a limited number of places on its French-taught Engineering Programme.

EXCITING CAREER PROSPECTS

The Bachelor of Science in Engineering equips students with the skills needed for **direct entry into the workforce**. Graduates enjoy excellent career prospects in organisations of all sizes — from start-ups and SMEs to large international companies.

Career opportunities span a wide range of sectors, including:

Transport: automotive, aeronautical, naval and railway, Building, public works and sustainable construction, Energy, water and environment, Food and beverage industries, Health and biomedical, Robotics and telecommunications, Defence, Maritime industries (offshore and marine renewable energy).

TUITION FEES AND FINANCING

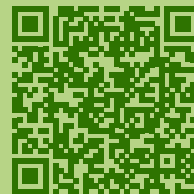
€12,000 per annum. Guaranteed for the duration of the programme.

Partial tuition fee waivers may be awarded based on scientific excellence criteria. The award is for the duration of the 3-year programme for a maximum annual amount of €3000.

Early bird applications may be awarded a tuition fee reduction for the first year of the programme.
