Centrale Nantes & Fondation Agissons pour l'Emploi selected in the second wave of the "100% Inclusion" call for projects launched by the French Ministry of Labour¹

Nantes, 23 April 2019

With the initiative "Agissons Pour l'Emploi PREPA / TREMPLIN", Centrale Nantes, has been selected in the second wave of the "100% Inclusion" call for projects within the Plan d'investissement dans les compétences (Skills Investment Plan). The results were announced in Marseille on Thursday 18 April 2019 by Muriel Pénicaud, Minister of Labour.

The project entitled PREPA / TREMPLIN aims to secure employment over a three-year period for 500 jobseekers who hold few or no qualifications, or live in priority urban neighbourhoods or rural areas. The principle is to open up



access to real career opportunities by meeting the needs of businesses in the expanding digital sector and industry of the future, particularly in the following regions: Pays de la Loire, Brittany and Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes.

PREPA / TREMPLIN stems from cooperation between Fondation Agissons Pour l'Emploi and Centrale Nantes, who decided to pool their skills, their networks and their resources to respond in the most effective way to the crucial issue of integration into the workforce for jobseekers in difficulty.
