Nantes, 9 October 2019

Meeting today, the Board of Governors at Centrale Nantes wishes to pursue its deliberations and continue work to collaborate more closely with the University of Nantes.

The Board of Governors at Centrale Nantes, convened on 9 October 2019, did not approve, as they stand, the proposed amendments to the statutes and creation of the future experimental institution named Nantes University.

However, the Board mandated the director of Centrale Nantes to set out a methodology to pursue work in progress and to report back at its next meeting.

Looking beyond the result of this vote, which management notes with a certain regret, the school reaffirms its willingness to continue discussions with the University of Nantes.
